

 Important Announcement: Whiting Station Board of Trustee Election Update

Dear Whiting Station Community Members,

We hope this message finds you well. We would like to bring to your attention a discrepancy in the election information previously provided. Due to a typographical error, there was a difference in the dates mentioned for declaring your candidacy for the upcoming Whiting Station Board of Trustee election. We sincerely apologize for any confusion this may have caused.

The correct and final date for declaring yourself as a candidate to run for a Whiting Station Board of Trustee position in the October 2nd election is August 16th. This date supersedes any previous information regarding an August 14th deadline. In the interest of fairness to all interested parties, we have confirmed that August 16th will be the cutoff date for those wishing to be included on the ballot.

If you are interested in contributing to the betterment of our community and wish to serve as a Trustee, we encourage you to take this opportunity. To proceed, kindly fill out the candidate application form. You can either deposit the completed form in the HOA mail slot located in the clubhouse or submit it via email to lsweezo@comcast.net

It's important to note that we have four trustee positions up for election this year, with three of them being two-year terms and one being a one-year term. As the HOA requires a minimum of four trustees to effectively conduct business, your participation in this election is crucial. Without a board of four or more members, we risk not having a quorum in accordance with our bylaws.

Furthermore, it's imperative to emphasize the potential consequences of not having a functioning Board of Trustees. In the absence of a viable board, there is a real possibility of a court-appointed receivership taking control of our community. This could result in not only the loss of community control but also incurring significant expenses. We all share a common goal of maintaining the vibrancy and harmony of our neighborhood, and your involvement can prevent such scenarios.

We acknowledge the skills and competence of our residents and the valuable contributions they can bring to the Board of Trustees. If you have been considering taking on this role, we welcome you to join us in this capacity. Your dedication, skills, and passion for our community are highly valued.

Time is of the essence, as the deadline for declaring your candidacy is fast approaching. Remember, Wednesday, August 16th, is the final day to submit your declaration. Don't miss this opportunity to play an active role in shaping the future of our community.
